HRSA Improvement Requirement



The Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 requires eligible entities to continue to track and report information demonstrating that the program results in improvements for the eligible families participating in the program in at least four out of the six benchmark areas. As documented in the MIECHV Program Guidance on Meeting Requirements to Demonstrate Improvement in Benchmark Areas, improvement in a benchmark area is defined as meeting the identified measure-level improvement criteria in at least one-third (33.3%) of the measures under a specified benchmark area (rounded to the closest whole number), with a minimum of improvement in at least one measure for each benchmark area.

For each of the 19 measures, improvement will be measured by comparing the awardee's FY 2020 measure-level performance data to both baseline data for that measure as well as the national threshold. Improvement for a measure is defined as meeting one or both of the following criteria:

- 1) Any change in the intended direction for that measure, as compared to baseline.
- 2) Meeting or exceeding the established threshold for a measure, while simultaneously not decreasing performance from baseline by more than 10%.

Measure 6 – Tobacco Cessation Referrals

Primary caregivers who report using tobacco or cigarettes at enrollment are referred to tobacco cessation counseling or services within 3 months of enrollment. If they are receiving tobacco cessation services at enrollment, a referral is not necessary. (EAR Enrollment Report- Primary Caregiver, Quarterly Report- Primary Caregiver)

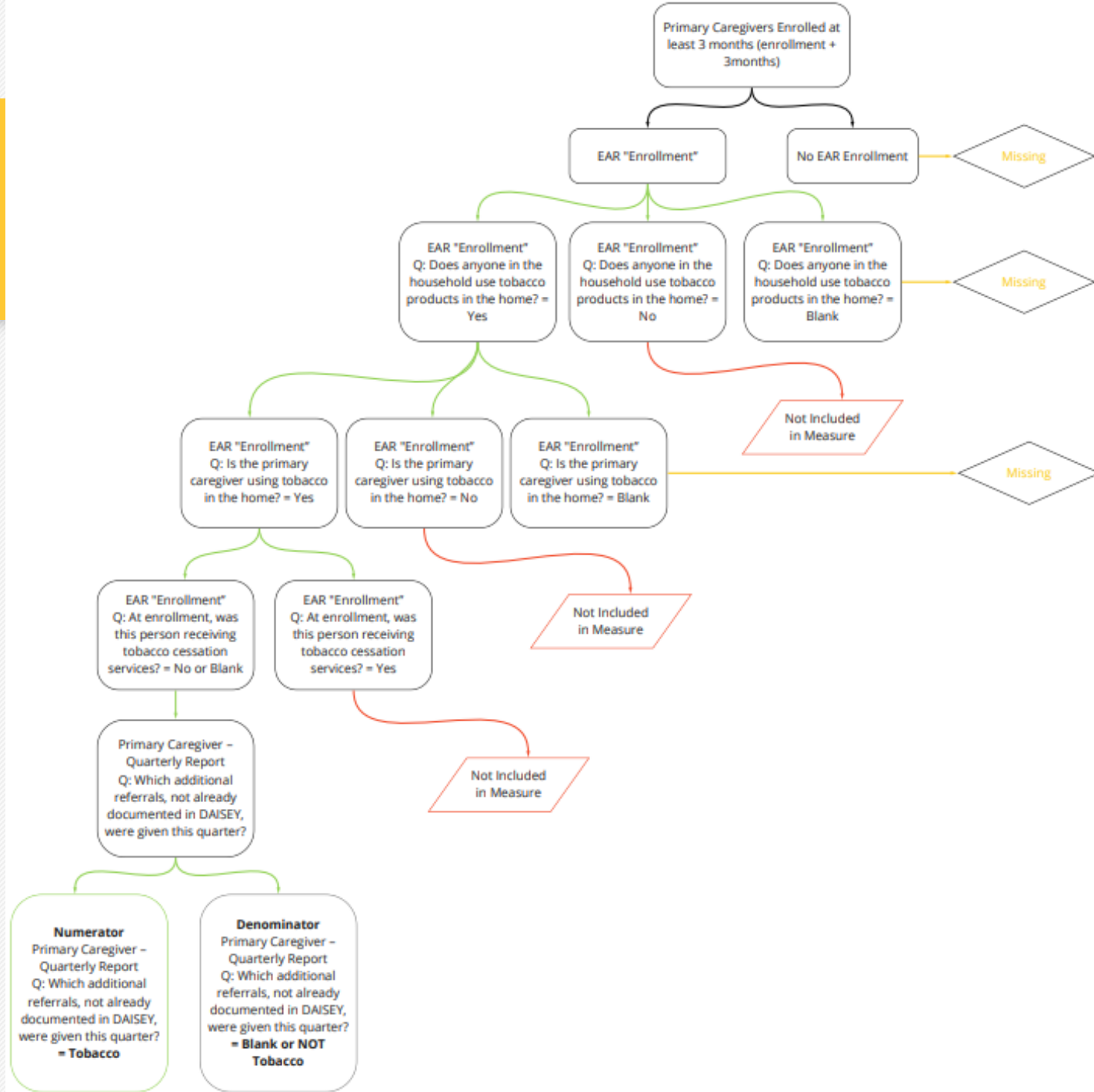
Of the caregivers in the denominator that received a tobacco cessation referral before the referral was due (3 months from enrollment) on the Quarterly Report- Caregiver. Must answer *"Tobacco"* on the question *"Which additional referrals, not already documented in DAISEY, were given this quarter?"* to access the *"Date of Tobacco Cessation referral?"* question.

Primary caregivers who indicated using tobacco use in the home at enrollment and who have reached 3 months post enrollment. Primary caregivers are excluded from Measure 6 if already receiving tobacco cessation services at enrollment.

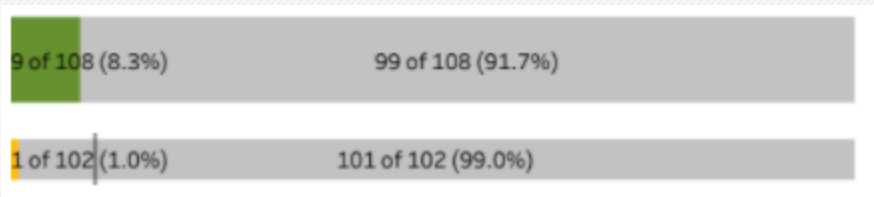

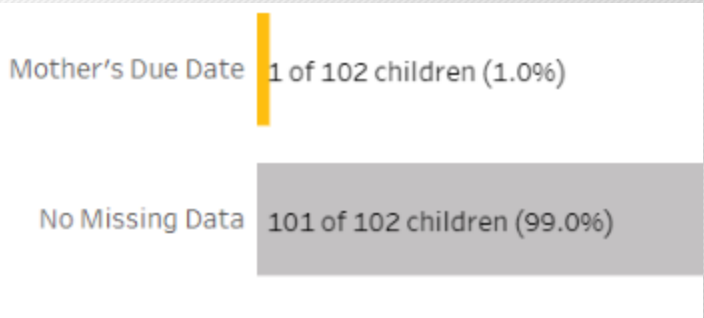

HRSA Benchmark - Measure 6

To correct missing data:

1. Find primary caregiver/target child DAISEY ID in report (previous slide).
2. In DAISEY, open the profile and visit family activities in DAISEY.
3. Edit Enrollment Annual Report (EAR) for reporting period.
4. Complete missing information identified in Missing Data dashboard of the Benchmark Report.
5. Save form.
6. Review report the following day (reports update every night).
7. If it doesn't fix the error and you still aren't sure, consult with your Supervisor.

HRSA Benchmarks - Measure 7

Safe Sleep - Percent of infants enrolled in home visiting that are always placed to sleep on their backs, without bed-sharing or soft bedding

Number of infants (index child aged less than 1 year) enrolled in home visiting whose primary caregiver reports that they are always placed to sleep on their backs, without bedsharing or soft bedding

HRSA Benchmarks - Measure 7

How do we address monthly data collection with conflicting information? For example, the caregiver indicates safe sleep for 10 months and co-sleeping one time in the 11th month? Does this mean the participant should not be included in the numerator?

A: This measure may be assessed at numerous times throughout the reporting period. However, it is only required to be assessed once per reporting period. If measured at multiple points in time (such as by asking the primary caregiver during each visit), then the assessment completed closest to the end of the reporting period should be reported.

HRSA Benchmarks - Measure 7

Enrollment & Annual Report - Targeted Child

Was the child referred to Early Intervention services at any point this reporting period?

Was the child 12 months old at any point this reporting period?

Was the infant always placed to sleep on his/her back, without bed sharing or soft bedding?

Was the child breastfed at any point this reporting period?

HRSA Benchmarks - Measure 7

Home Visit Review Form

The intent of the following question is to measure whether [at the time of the home visit](#), the caregiver is always using safe sleep practices, not whether the child has experienced safe sleep practices for the entirety of their life. If the caregiver says they always use safe sleep practices at the most [current](#) home visit, then they are counted as in compliance, and the "Yes" box should be checked.

Note: if the target child is over 12 months of age or this is a prenatal visit, select *Not applicable*.

Was the infant always placed to sleep on their back, without bed sharing or soft bedding? *

HRSA Benchmarks - Measure 17

*Measure 17 – Complete Depression Referrals

Primary caregivers referred to services for a positive screen on the Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale who complete the referral. (Quarterly Report- Primary Caregiver)

Of the primary caregivers in the denominator that answer "Yes" to the question "If the caregiver was provided a depression referral, was that referral completed?" on the Quarterly Report- Primary Caregiver in the reporting period.

Of primary caregivers screened resulting in a positive screening that reached 60 days post-screening (even if in past reporting periods).

HRSA Benchmark - Measure 17 (FY19 training)

Measure 17 - Depression Referrals

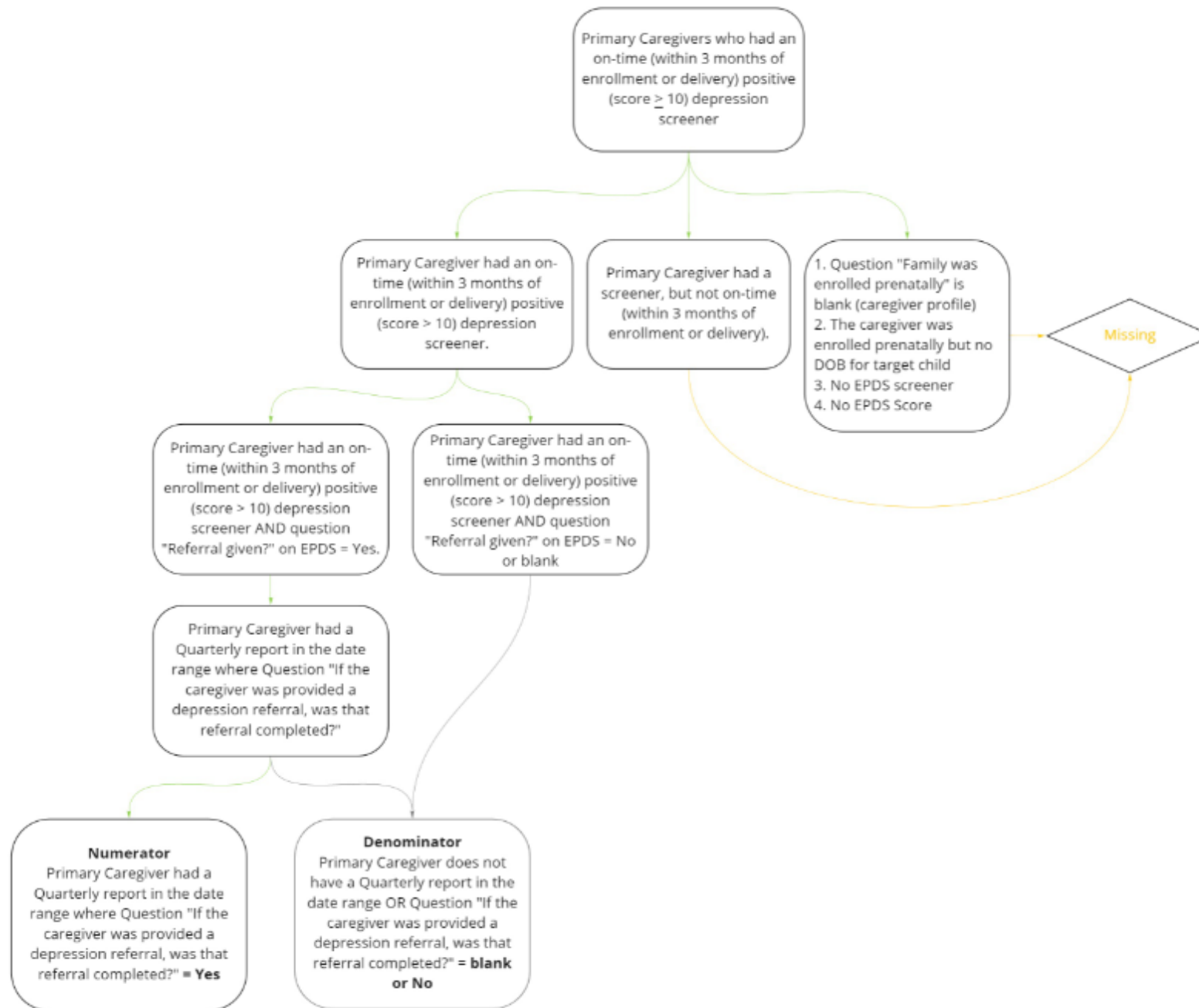
HRSA is requiring that states include any primary caregiver that has EVER been included in this denominator until they meet the numerator.

Form: EPDS

Update: Any primary caregiver meeting the denominator will remain in count until they are included in the numerator. This is more of a cumulative count now.

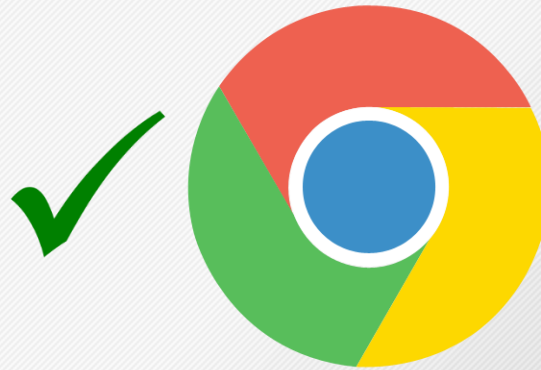
